SETTING UP OF MINI FRUIT PROCESSING PLANTS FOR SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES AND COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES

The Ministry of Industrial Development, SMEs and Cooperatives (SMEs Division) is inviting Applications for grant scheme from existing and/or potential Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs)/Cooperative Societies willing to set up Mini Fruit Processing Plants.

2. The objective is to convert locally available fruits into value added products, for example, fruit juice, jam, syrup or other fruit-based products.
3. A financial grant (up to a maximum of Rs One Million) will be provided to a maximum of three (3) selected SMEs/Cooperative Societies to cover 50 percent of the cost of equipment and machinery procured to set up the Plant.
4. Interested SMEs/Cooperative Societies are invited to submit their 'Application for grant scheme' as per the set up Guidelines in a sealed envelope and marked 'Mini-Fruit Processing Plant' on the left-hand corner to the Acting Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Industrial Development, SMEs and Cooperatives (SMEs Division) and should be deposited in the Registry at 16th floor, Newton Tower, Sir William Newton Street, Port Louis, **at latest by noon on Thursday 21 December 2023.**
